Our reconciliation efforts focus primarily on Messianic/Gentile Believers, Charismatic/Non-Charismatic Christians, and various pro-Israel groups.

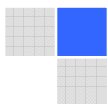
Reconciliation will regenerate these communities and hasten the coming of Jesus Christ by a loving witness to all.
