Greetings Road to Jerusalem Intercessors and Warriors!

As a word of reminder, the Road To Jerusalem website (www.roadtojerusalem.org) will be our primary means of intercessory communication with prayer updates and periodic teachings on prayer. The prayer ministry is still in the developmental stages because we are working on a volunteer basis and many of us are not currently living in the Denver area. This is not a problem for God. He knows how to form His army of intercessors and is more than able to teach us to move as one with Him no matter what the physical distance may be. Was not that an amazing time of prayer during the Hampton conference? Wow, that night when the volunteers showed up to sign up we were catapulted immediately into His presence and I believe much was accomplished. There was a spirit of oneness and liberty that covered the atmosphere around us. Thank you to all who participated. It was a real privilege to have served with you there in Hampton. Paulette Washington had an awesome dream that indicated the Lord is sewing together a “patchwork-pattern” which we understand to represent the “covering” that God is forming for this ministry.

This week we are entering “The Feast of Trumpets” or Rosh Hashanah...an extremely important and holy time on the Biblical calendar. The scriptures are clear that these are the “Feasts of the Lord” and not just the Feasts of the Israel. Therefore it brings new light upon the responsibility

that the Christian church has to embrace and celebrate these feasts with the Lord who has called them by His own name. Most of you are familiar with the Biblical implications surrounding such a holy time. I want to highlight the blowing of the trumpet as it marks the beginning of the festival, which begins on September 13th, 2007. This is the beginning of a 10-day preparation of repentance and cleansing before entering the New Year or Yom Kippur, which begins on September 22, 2007. Never before in my walk with God have I sensed such urgency for cleansing and the preparing of our hearts before a holy God.

The sound of the ram's horn/shofar/trumpet of the Lord is a sign and symbol of the "VOICE OF GOD". See Numbers 10:9,10 and Psalm 29. I love these passages for they direct us to the unlimited ways in which God wants to speak to His people. I would ask you to join with me in praying and prophetically declaring the VOICE OF LOVE that pulverizes the voice of fear that has been seeking to gain influence of the Lord's people. Someone has said that since "Perfect love casts out fear" according to I John 4:18, then perhaps the opposite is true that fear casts out love.

Lord Jesus and Beloved Yeshua,
We ask that as the trumpet blows during this Rosh Hashanah celebration that the reality of your love would overtake your Bride as never before. We ask that your voice would free us to "live and move and have our being in You" unlike anything we have "dared to ask, think or imagine". Let the sound of the trumpet blast change our very DNA so that as we confess that you alone are God the

earth would begin to come into her God intended alignment. Let it be done in earth (our earthen clay) as it is in Heaven. We repent of our wilderness ways and confess that we want the promised land of your love and we choose to leave behind the bondage of fear. Come Lord Jesus and release your sound in the earth. “The Lord will give strength to His people; The Lord will bless His people with peace.” Psalm 29:11. Please keep the leaders, and the fulltime staff of The Road To Jerusalem” in your prayers. We need to help them carry this burden in prayer and those who work in the private prayer closet will receive their reward from the Lord who sees all. Press on brethren. The Breakthroughs we have been crying out for are at hand.
